Perhaps another card will provide you with different inspiration - "Immerse yourself in the composer's world. Use your own voice to tell their stories. We are connected through our shared humanity." I've turned to this little black box several times of late - when working on a new arrangement, and not sure where it's headed. Contemplating the words on the cards - and seeing the subtle differences in the artwork - has certainly provided inspiration for my work and its journey.
